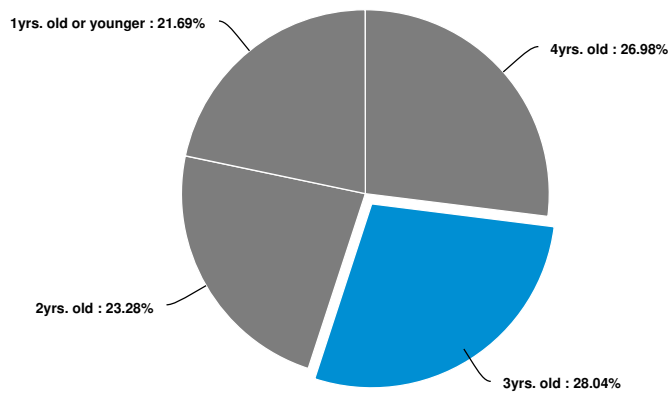

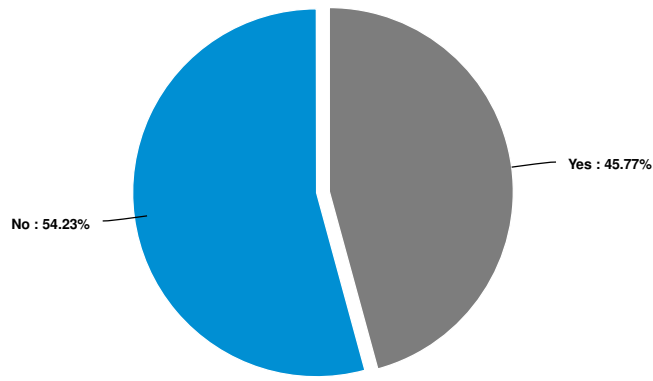

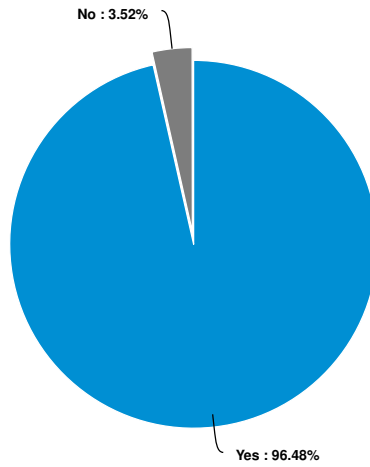

Do you have a child/children currently enrolled at Lafayette Elementary School for this school year (2020-2021)?



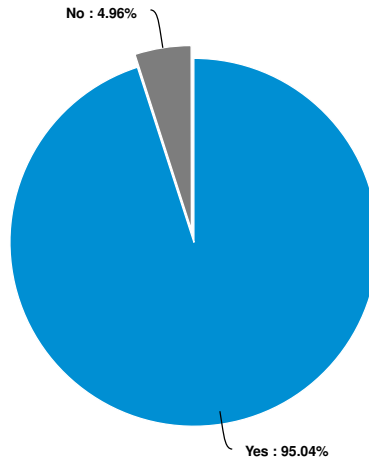

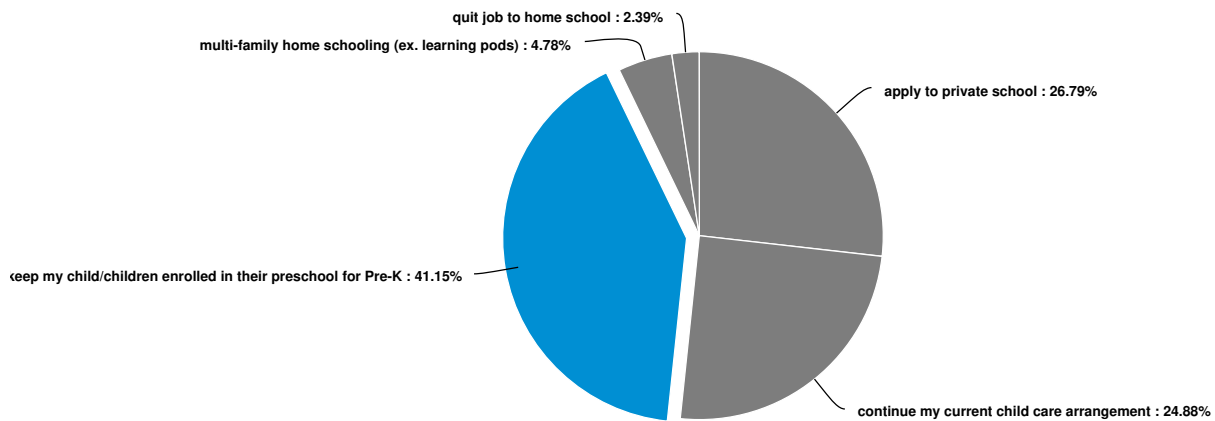

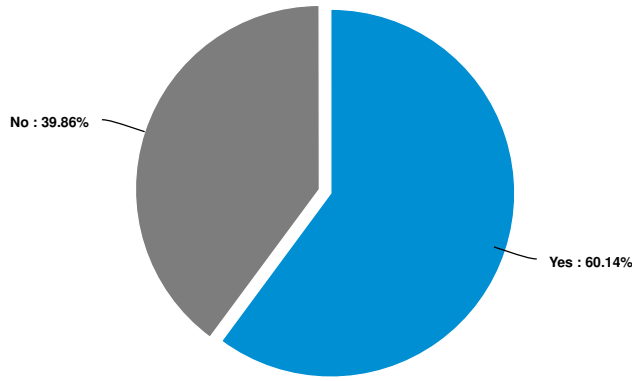

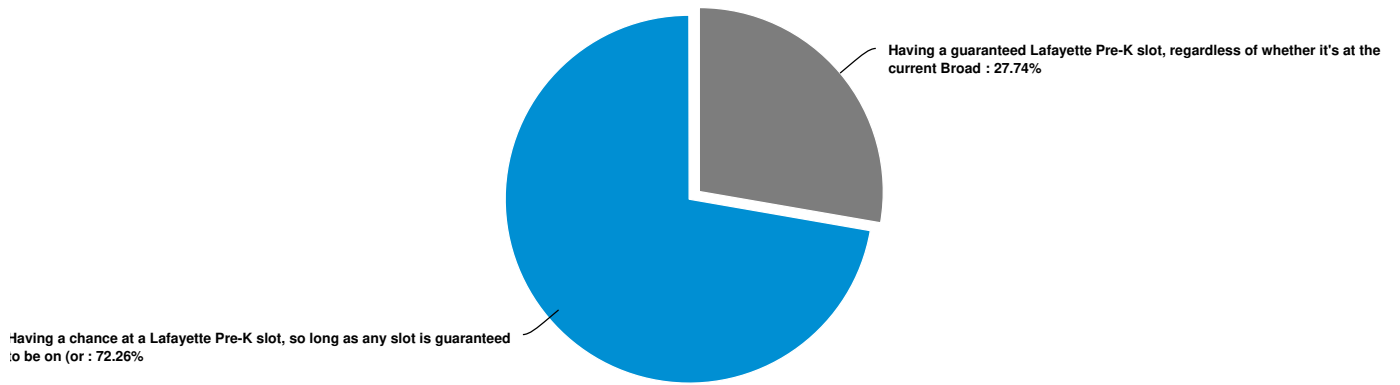

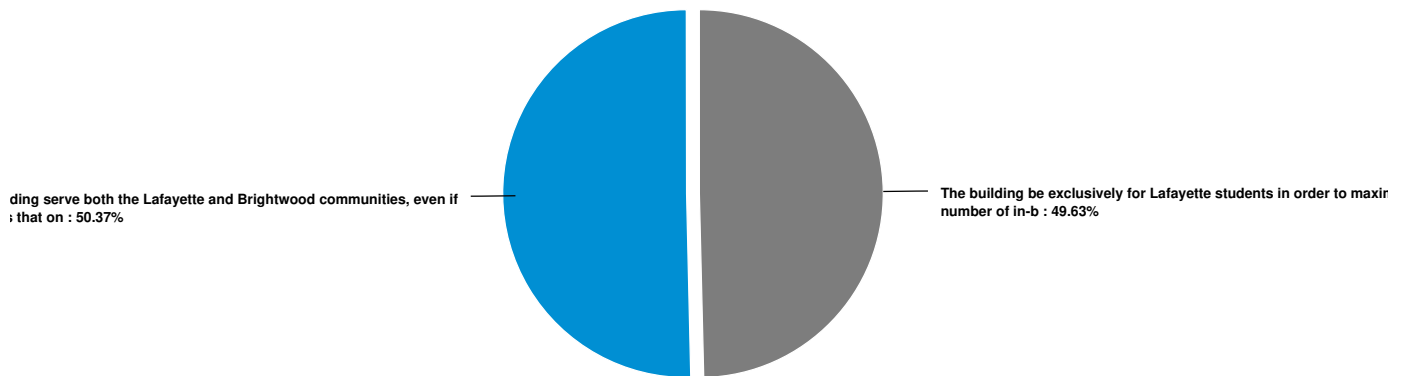


Which is more important to you?



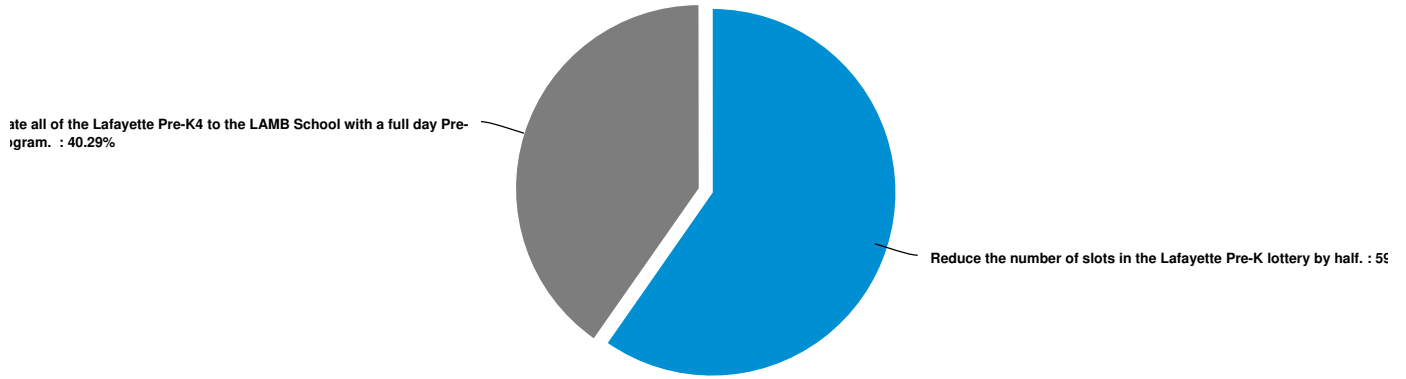
