#### II. Four Week Review & Lookahead

#### Four Week Review

- MCN mobilization
  - Installation of permit and signage board
  - o Communication of site rules to the MCN team and subcontractors
  - Friday, February 3: Held kickoff meeting with Ranjit Babra of the DDOT Urban Forestry Division (UFD) to review heritage tree protection plan
  - Monday, February 6: Held preconstruction meeting with Brent Levy of the Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE) to review sediment and erosion control measures
- Installed heritage tree critical root zone protection fencing around seven heritage trees per tree preservation plan and UFD direction
- Installed sediment and erosion control measures per tree transplant plan and DOEE instruction
- Installed security fencing on Nebraska Ave. frontage
- Completed removal of trees as identified in tree removal permits TA90191 and TA88465
- Began mulching removed trees and build mulch access roads for tree transplant vehicular traffic
- Began hauling off spoils from demolition
- DDOT inspector visit on 3/2/23
  - O Inspector requested that orange snow fence be removed and re-installed 40 feet from the street
  - O Inspector requested that Maret rendering sign be placed 40 feet from the street (expected reinstallation to take place on Monday, 3/6/23)
  - O Inspector removed other signs from Nebraska Ave. MCN employee assisted neighbor with walking signage back to their home
- Periodic inspection visits from MCN site safety supervisor

### Lookahead

- Complete mulching removed trees and build mulch access roads for tree transplant vehicular traffic
- Complete hauling off spoils from demolition
- Additional coordination with DDOT on site access
- Begin transplanting trees as designated on tree transplant plan Exact start dates are TBD
  - o Transplant Week 1 Mobilization and Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan
  - Transplant Week 2 Encapsulate root balls of all four trees and install piping under root balls of trees 1 and 2
  - o Transplant Week 3 Install the structural frame to support the transplants of trees 1 and 2
  - o Transplant Week 4 Transplant trees 1 and 2 and backfill and dress the two trees
  - Transplant Week 5 Install piping under root balls of trees 3 and 4 and install structural frame to support the transplants of trees 3 and 4
  - o Transplant Week 6 Transplant trees 3 and 4 and backfill and dress the two trees
  - Transplant Week 7 Complete final grading around trees, install irrigation and mulch and demobilize equipment
- Continued inspection from MCN site safety supervisor
