ANC 3/4G FIELD TASK FORCE COMMUNITY UPDATE #6 - 5/18/2023

On Wednesday, May 17 from 7:00 to 7:40 PM, the ANC 3/4G Field Task Force held our fifth public meeting via Zoom. The 5/17 meeting was called to order by Task Force Co-Chair Jenny Backus at 7:03 PM. Four of the five Task Force members were in attendance including Co-Chair Mike Osborne, Task Force Community Member Marek Gootman, along with NC 3/4G-02 Commissioner Bruce Sherman. In addition, non-voting Task Force members Trey Holloway from Maret, Johnny Seikaly from MCN Build, and Stephanie Nash from the ECC were in attendance. There were 3 community members who RSVP'd via the RSVP form and 1 member of the community joined on Zoom throughout the meeting.

Trey Holloway introduced the meeting attendees and the Task Force to Terry Fauntleroy from <u>Brailsford and Dunlavey</u>, the new firm he had mentioned that Maret was bringing on to serve as their "owner's rep" at our last Task Force meeting. Terry and Trey talked about how BDConnect will be assisting Maret with timelines, budgets, and permitting and working closely with MCN Build on community outreach and engagement.

The meeting included an update from Maret and MCN Build regarding activities to date on the field, questions from the Task Force members, a review of community questions and concerns to date that have been received by the Task Force, and questions from the community member in attendance. One complaint had been lodged via the ANC Field TF Complaint form regarding the placement of the final Heritage Tree.

Top line highlights of the meeting include:

- The tree transplantation process is complete and all four Heritage trees have been successfully moved.
 The irrigation system is installed for all of the transplanted trees and the engineers have been out multiple times to check everything and ensure trees are healthy and everything is working properly.
 The team has backfilled the soil and seeded and strawed over the areas where the trees were originally.
- A neighbor had contacted the Task Force via the <u>ANC Field Task Force Complaint form</u> about the position of the 4th tree that was moved adjacent to her house. It appeared from photos she provided that the tree could fall over onto her property. Trey Holloway said they had contacted the neighbor and confirmed with the engineers and tree specialists that the tree was secure and there was wiring holding it in place.

- MCN announced that now the tree transplantation project was complete, they would be providing window washing for adjacent neighbors most impacted by the dust. The TF will work with MCN to identify the neighbors and follow-up.
- The ECC site should be relatively quiet over the summer while Maret/MCN and BD Connect finalize budgeting, timelines and planning. The construction orange signs have been removed from Nebraska Ave.
- The TF asked Maret to update the community about what is coming next in terms of the project and reshare plans of what the field would look like since their sign (which had been defaced) is not up anymore. Commissioner Sherman also said folks were interested in what kinds of plantings and new trees Maret was planning for on the site.
- Commissioner Sherman also highlighted some concerns he said he heard from community members including the chemical PFAS and the use of artificial turf, and a request for any updated plans for traffic flow and congestion mitigation once the field is built.
- The Task Force chairs stressed the importance of using the ANC Field email <u>ancfieldtf@gmail.com</u> and the <u>ANC Task Force Complaint/Question</u> form so questions could be tracked and shared for transparency.

The meeting concluded at 7:48 PM.
