**Resolution in Opposition to Renaming a Portion of H Street in the
Name of Charlie Kirk
November 24, 2025**

SUMMARY: Senator Rick Scott has introduced [S.2998](#), a bill to designate the area of H Street Northwest between Connecticut Avenue Northwest and Vermont Avenue Northwest in Washington, District of Columbia (DC), as “Charlie Kirk Patriot Way.”

WHEREAS: [S.2998](#) is cosponsored by Senators Mike Lee, Josh Hawley, Bernie Moreno, Marsha Blackburn, and Ted Cruz;

WHEREAS: [S.2998](#) was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs on October 9, 2025;

WHEREAS: in June 2020, the District of Columbia officially renamed two blocks of 16th Street NW between K Street and H Street as Black Lives Matter Plaza NW, located near the area proposed for renaming;

WHEREAS: renaming a nearby street after Charlie Kirk diminishes the pride the city took in creating Black Lives Matter Plaza and is offensive to many Washingtonians – especially Black Washingtonians – who may view such proximity as disrespectful to a space that symbolized racial justice;

WHEREAS: Mr. Charlie Kirk’s views are antithetical to the principals of diversity, equity and inclusion, and broadly divisive; he has criticized gay and transgender rights, Jews, Islam, and women’s equality, asserting that women should be submissive and obedient to men.

WHEREAS: Mr. Charlie Kirk has also disparaged Black and African American communities, claiming that women are not intelligent enough to be taken seriously and fabricating statistics about the number of Black children raised in single parent homes;

WHEREAS: the District of Columbia takes pride in its diversity, rooted in its Black and Latino communities and enriched by residents from all walks of life;

WHEREAS: Washingtonians deserve to honor the leaders who support, defend, and embody the city's values;

WHEREAS: Mr. Charlie Kirk has no meaningful connection to Washington, DC., and none of the sponsors of [S.2998](#) represent the District; DC residents are best positioned to determine whom to honor in their city;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 3/4G strongly opposes renaming H Street – or any portion thereof – or any street, D.C. government building or anything in the District of historical significance in the name of Charlie Kirk.
- While supporting the constitution protection of free speech, ANC 3/4G affirms its opposition to any words or action promoting racism, bigotry, sexism, antisemitism, Islamophobia, political violence, or discrimination based on sexual orientation or gender identity.
- ANC 3/4G urges the Council of the District of Columbia and the Mayor oppose [S.2998](#) as divisive and inconsistent with the morals, principles, and core values of the people of the District of Columbia.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Commissioners Simmons and Gore shall be the designated ANC 3/4G representatives for all matters related to this resolution.

ADOPTED at a regular meeting, notice of which was properly given, and at which a quorum of four (4) of seven (7) members was present on November 24, 2025, by a vote of 7 yes, 0 no, 0 abstentions.
